FLOWS Framework Development

Flows Framework Development has been developed as an innovative framework for identifying participants' transferable skills that will benefit them in accessing the labour market. This framework is designed to help those disadvantaged in the labour market to identify skills and strengths that they may not be aware of.

In the first phase of the Flows project, the project partners carried out national research and a range of activities to gather the information presented in this document as a broader transnational framework. In this synthesis report, findings have been collected to provide an insight into the current situation of skills for the future labour market in several European countries and to identify structural challenges faced by young jobseekers in each partner country: Austria, Ireland, Romania and Turkey. We obtained important information on employability in a globalised society and on digitalisation and future job opportunities.


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Tool Specification and Content

The Flows Project has developed a Tool Specification and Content that explains the FLOWS Tool within the overall guidance process and shows the context and theories behind the FLOWS Tool and Content specifications.

What is the FLOWS tool?

The FLOWS Learning Tool is an assessment and development tool used to support people in their career exploration and development. The tool is designed to enable participants to discover their own skills and competencies that are present in their everyday lives. Using a strengths-based approach, the tool should allow participants to reflect on their daily activities and the skills they use.
